Entry forms – completing instructions :

Please fill in the entry forms with block writing or type writing. Unreadable forms will not be accepted and will be returned to exhibitors. There is no organizer's responsibility for incorrect entry form filling. The proof of fee payments must be attached to the entry form, otherwise the entry form will not be accepted and will be returned to exhibitors. Each dog can only participate in one particular class. If taking part in Champion class or Working class, the copy of championship title or work exam must be enclosed in the entry form. If there is no such a document present, the dog will be automatically entered into open class. Acceptance of dogs entries will be confirmed by e-mail. By accepting the entry form, the organizers are liable to ČMKU exhibitions regulations and to all rules stated in this document. Exhibitor agrees that the information provided to organizers will be used in the show catalogue and Briard Club web pages.

General regulations :

Dogs entering the show must turn the age eligible for each particular class and be registered by Briard clubs that are subjects to FCI order. Imported dogs to CZ must be registered in Czech studbook. Organizers are not responsible for damage caused to exhibitors or their dogs, as well not for the death of animals or their loss. Dogs are not allowed to move freely and their owners must keep them on the leash. The exhibition committee has the privilege to refuse the entry form without giving any reason. Exterior changes to the dog's coat by using coloring hairspray and longtime mooring of dogs on the show-tables is strictly prohibited. Bitches that are in the season are not eligible for the show. As well animals that are in advance stage of pregnancy, or after veterinary operation causing exterior changes, are not allowed to enter the show. Cropped ears animals will not be admitted to the show and will not be judged..

If not stated otherwise, the regulations of ČMKU (Czech and Moravian Cynology Union) come in force. The entry fee will be used to cover the exhibition costs in case the show will not be held for objective reasons. Exhibitors agree to publish their personal information in the catalogue.

Veterinary rules and regulations:

All show dogs must be provided with veterinary passport. Antirabies vaccination must be applied at least 30 days before the show and must not be older than 1 year. The dog must have immunity to parvovirus and distemper.
